



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

STATE INSTITUTE FOR ISLAMIC STUDIES (IAIN) OF JEMBER, INDONESIA

and

MUSLIM ASSOCIATION OF KRABI, THAILAND

In order to promote the mutual interests between the Parties, State Institute for Islamic Studies (IAIN) of Jember, Indonesia, and Muslim Association of Krabi, Thailand, agree to exercise their best efforts to develop the following forms of cooperation:

- a) Joint academic programs, including research activities;
- b) Exchange of information, including research publications;
- c) Exchange of teaching staff for the development of both institutions:
- d) Exchange of undergraduate and graduate students for study and research;
- e) Exchange of community services, including exchange of social-cultural activities;
- f) Invitations of authorized officials to visit and to develop cooperative mechanisms between the parties;
- g) Islamic-related teaching and learning practices;
- h) International seminars, conferences, and workshops; and
- i) Scholarships.

Both parties shall appoint a coordinator from each party for the development and management of joint activities.

Both parties understand that all financial arrangements will have to be negotiated and will depend on the availability of funds.

Details for the implementation of specific projects will be mutually developed.

In the event that both parties formalize the abovementioned academic and research collaboration, the parties have agreed on a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) of which the MoU has a binding effect on both parties.
